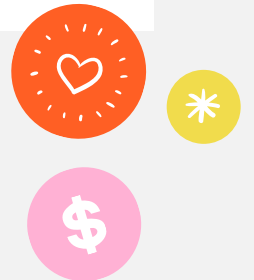
SPONSORSHIP TIERS
